## **Dynamics**

The word "dynamic" in regular language means "changing", and the Greek root δύναμις dúnamis, means "power".

In music dynamics are how 10ud or soft to play...or how much power to apply.

Dynamic symbols are abbreviations of Italian words, some of which are similar to Spanish words that you might know.

Symbol	Name	Meaning
ppp	pianississimo	as soft as you can play
pp	pianissimo	very soft
p	piano	soft
тр	mezzopiano	medium soft
mf	mezzoforte	medium loud
f	forte	loud (or strong)
ff	fortissimo	very loud
fff	fortississimo	as loud as you can play

In addition to the abbreviation symbols, there are also *crescendos*, written as

cresc...or

This tells you to gradually get louder

and decrescendos or dimminuendos, written as

decresc. . . or dim. . . or

This tells you to gradually get Softer

These words also come from Italian and Latin, with "crescere" originally meaning "to grow", and "diminuendo" corresponding to English "diminish"
